



Classifier Scoresheet

Instructions:

String 1: The shooter starts standing with hands at sides and with the handgun loaded with six rounds and holstered. Upon the start signal, the shooter will engage a target at 25 yards and a target at 50 yards, both from the standing position with one shot each.

String 2: The shooter starts standing with hands at sides and with the handgun loaded with six rounds and holstered. Upon the start signal, the shooter will engage a target at 50 yards and a target at 75 yards, both from a kneeling position with one shot each. Kneeling requires at least one knee to be touching the ground.

String 3: The shooter starts standing with hands at sides and with the handgun loaded with six rounds and holstered. Upon the start signal, the shooter will engage a target at 75 yards and a target at 100 yards, both from either the prone or supine position with one shot each.

Notes:

- 1 Put an X in the corresponding box for a hit, a O for a miss.
- 2 Targets on all strings are worth 15 points each.
- 3 No makeup shots are allowed on any strings during the classifier.
- 4 Time and points will be recorded individually for each string.
- 5 Hit factor for each string is the total points for each string divided by the time,
- 6 Final classifier score is the sum of the hit factors for each string.
